



B - Rich Stichler's European and Japanese Z layouts 90 Creekview Dr, Ringgold, GA 30736 Handicap accessible in garage ~ 423-653-0854

Rich has two separate 2' x 3' portable layouts. The European layout is fully detailed with mountains, tunnels, bridges, a castle, streets and vehicles. The Japanese layout includes an engine house, turntable, bridges and a bustling town. The buildings include an impressive amount of detail, and both passenger and freight trains glide across the sleek track work.

C - Ed Painter's Virginia Piedmont, Appalachian and Western Railway 5265 Red Clay Rd, Cohutta, GA 30701 Enter via front door, downstairs *NOT handicap accessible* ~ 678-350-5424

This HO scale railroad is a loose representation of the Appalachian Mountain region of Southwest Virginia and Southern West Virginia as well as the Piedmont region of Virginia. The main benchwork is built in a basic "U" configuration, 42' long with 90-degree wings of 16' and 18' at each end measuring 6' across.

Work on the layout began during the winter of 2018 with the entire double track mainline and several long passing sidings powered by NCE DCC wireless control system. Track 30% completed.

Additionally, Ed's house is conveniently situated where Norfolk Southern's single track is located with an average of more than 40 trains a day. Great for railfanning!





D - David Holsinger's Nona County Rails 1035 Bramblewood Trail NW, Cleveland, TN 37311 Enter via backyard into basement **Handicap accessible** ~ 423-339-0650

This 13' x 30' HO layout features a variety of mid-west railroads running on four separate mainlines, each on a separate level.

The "farm side" of the layout includes stock pens, soybean and corn fields (including 8000 handmade cornstalks!), and greenhouses; the "industrial side" of the layout includes an oil terminal, a cement plant, grain elevators, and numerous other detailed scenes.

The railroad is 100% complete with DC control.

E - Willie Clonts' Soddy Daisy Southern

11629 Guth Rd, Soddy Daisy, TN 37379 Park in driveway, layout is in building out back. Handicap accessible ~ 423-718-5989

This freelanced HO scale railroad is a 16 x 40 foot layout, set in Appalachia during the 1930-1949 period. It is a beautiful scenic railroad, featuring two harbors, an operating swing bridge, multiple craftsman kit-built and scratch-built buildings, piers, and barges.

The layout design is "around the room" style with a peninsula featuring 18" of elevation change. Steam engines are the prevalent power with first generation diesel being added.

The layout has recently doubled in size and is a must-see museum quality layout, built by a true artist.





F - Jim Bailiff's HO scale Sharonville Division 480 Patten Chapel Rd, Chattanooga, TN 37419 Park in driveway, enter around left side to back door. **Handicap accessible** ~ 423-322-8192

This layout depicts the early 50s Cincinnati area, with 2 scale miles covering 780 sq. ft. built on recycled doors with cork roadbed and foam scenery. It is 100% complete using Digitrax system.

G - Jerry Holmes' S scale C&O Allegheny Sub

1164 Cumberland Rd, Chattanooga, TN 37419 Park in driveway, use front door. *NOT handicap accessible* ~ 423-821-8708

The 945 sq. ft. layout built on L girders, depicting the autumn of 1952 from Hilton WV to Clifton VA. It is built on Homabed with code 100 Shinohara track and #8 turnouts. The scenery is foam and plaster, with Mike Tylick structures and uses the NCE system.

H - Barry Miller's Lookout Mountain Southern

1605 Fairy Dell Trail, Lookout Mountain, GA 30750 Handicapped accessible but has a small step ~ 423-313-5318

This HO scale layout is a 24' x 13' freelanced, present day, multilevel layout, representing the NS and CSX on the Chattanooga to Wauhatchie route.

The railroad features lower staging on both sides of the dogbone design and two helixes, allowing for continuous running, switching, and self-staging for operations. The layout uses Digitrax, it's track work is 40% complete and scenery at 20%. There are several industries to switch.

Also featured are multiple prototype bridges that will certainly "Catch your eye."



J - Brian Ford's HO BN Monett Sub 1208 Laurelwood Dr, East Ridge, TN 37412 Park in driveway, enter around right side to back door. Handicap accessible with a slight slope ~ 423-297-5726

This HO layout is designed for operations and models the Springfield area of the BN in the mid-1990's. It features Springfield Yard with many of the actual on-line industries. Under construction but with Springfield yard and an additional 50 ft of the mainline powered up, this layout uses a variety of non-traditional construction techniques and materials.

K - Chip Chipman's HO Concord Central

6906 Phyllis Ln, Chattanooga, TN 37421 Park in driveway or street, layout is in the detached garage. Handicap accessible ~ 423-304-0818

The freelanced layout covers the 1980's to 1990's in the Chattanooga area. The layout covers 2.5 scale miles, featuring classification and intermodal yards, locomotive shop, and several large industries such as grain elevator and scrap yard (with real rust debris!). Concord Central provides the local switching for the various NS and CSX mainline freights.

L - Ed Tougaw's N scale Intermont & Western Virginia 209 Dailey Hills Terrace, Ringgold GA 30736 Enter around right side to back door Handicapped accessible ~ 423-280-9105

The I&WV Railroad is located in the south-western tip of Virginia set in steam transition era of the 1950's. It serves as a bridge line between the Interstate and the C&O. These connections generate traffic from several major lines. King Coal still rules on the I&WVRR.

This multi-level layout is under construction and features 3.5 scale miles of track, a major marshalling yard, facilities for servicing steam and diesel, and three coal branch lines. Ed uses traditional DC blocks and multiple tethered throttles.

TVRM and the Chattanooga Area Model Railroad Club are building a HO scale layout depicting a portion of the Rathole Division of the CNO&TP. The layout will cover an area of more than 1,850 sq. ft.

When completed the layout will be open to the public, running in an automated mode with 7 simultaneous trains and using the Digikeijs DCC system. The club will also have operating sessions. Benchwork has been completed and track laying has begun.

CSX and Norfolk Southern mainlines make for great railfan viewing at the TVRM station.

N - Bill Orman's HO MLS&T

11194 Captains Cove Dr, Soddy Daisy TN 37379 *NOT handicap accessible* ~ 423-243-6829

The MLS&T is a HO freelanced, present day railroad, depicting the Tennessee and Southern Kentucky landscape. Trains originate and return to Memphis, TN and Meridian, MS using a shared NS/ CSX mainline arriving in New Holland yard for distribution to several major industries.

The layout is primarily a switching layout with 128 feet of mainline, a branchline providing five industries to serve, and Seeburg-Simmons industrial park on a peninsula. Major industries served are an auto plant car loading facility, an auto transload facility to car carrier trucks, auto parts suppliers and other.

Additional traffic includes a coal fired power plant, salvage company, cement plant and flour mill providing a broad array of traffic on the railroad.







Loosely based on the Southern Railroad, the Knoxville, Atlanta, and Mobile Railroad (KAMR) is a subsidiary of the Southern and uses a lot of Southern equipment, similar to the NC&StL and the L&N. Great liberties are taken with both history and geography, while modeling the mainline from Cincinnati to Chattanooga and including the classification yard and passenger station in Knoxville.

The 30 by 40 ft. layout room is located within the west wing of the Children's Museum in Oak Ridge, approximately 2 hours northeast of the convention hotel. An N scale layout will be operating in the same building at the same time.

Major towns on the LS are Rockwood, Chattanooga, Bridgeport, Scottsboro and Huntsville. The layout has a 230' mainline on two levels in three rooms in the basement. NCE DCC and a wireless router allowing various smart phone devices to run the trains.


