
Ben Bartlett MMR - Detailing a structure with Walthers Modular Panels

If you've received the latest edition of the *NMRA Magazine* (formerly *Scale Rails*), you've seen the new NMRA logo. A fair amount of folks felt it was confusing and didn't really promote the organization. Some felt the membership should have had more input. I personally don't like it 'cause I didn't "get it" right away. (That's my problem though.) However, unless there's a mass movement with torches, tar and feathers, we need to accept the change and move forward. Anybody think of a better logo?

At this year's national convention, bids for the 2014 national convention were heard from representatives of Calgary, Cleveland and Memphis. After deliberation, Cleveland was selected. Too bad for Calgary. I was there for the national in 1979 and it was one of the best ones I ever attended. And naturally, Memphis would be a good choice because of its proximity to us.

The final count for paid registrations for this past summer's Milwaukee convention were over 1600. The 2010 National Train Show was larger than the last three with all 345 booths being sold. That's the official party line anyway...

It was announced at the Board meeting that an anonymous donor had pledged \$250,000 to be used as a matching grant for the model railroad display at the California State Railroad Museum. Remember that no NMRA dues or funds will be used to build the display, which will be seen by over 600,000 museum visitors a year.

After serving as head of Meetings and Trade Shows for 24 years, Henry Jordan will retire. His successor is current NMRA Legal Counsel Bob Amsler (served as chairman of the 2000 convention in San Jose).

Long time Membership Services Department Chair Jan Wescott has retired. She'll be replaced by Howard Goodwin (Piedmont Division superintendent).

Treasurer Kevin Feeney retired at the end of the Milwaukee Convention. That's interesting, 'cause he was in office only a year or so. I'll bet he doesn't get a gold watch. Wonder what that story was?

Our New Website!

We have finally uploaded our new division website. I apologize for taking so long but this old dog had to learn some new tricks. Thank you for your patience. Our new site is: www.division15nmra.com Some things you need to know:

There are URL links on the left hand side of each page. I hope you will find these useful. On the home page there is a calendar. Take your cursor and pass it over any date that is colored. Then left click on the colored box to see more detail about the event. At the top of the calendar, you can print a month, week or day at a time. When you go to the "Members Only" page it is password protected. Contact me at my e-mail address (see page 2) for your "members only" password.

Note: we are trying to have all files in PDF format. If you don't have Adobe Reader installed on your computer you will not be able to read these files. Adobe Reader is free; you can go to the Adobe website and download it.

When you go to the Past Newsletters page, you will see past newsletter files follow by page numbers. Left click on the page number to open the file.

When you go to the Clinics page, you will see many different categories. Right now there is only one clinic loaded (more to come). To open it left click on the file. Presently, there is a glitch as a password box pops up. To get by this, click on "Cancel" and the presentation will open. (Note: most clinics are done with Microsoft Power Point (such as the one currently shown), so some of you will not be able to view it. I am looking into converting Power Point presentations into PDF format.

When you go to Photo Galleria, this will take you to a Photo Album site where we store all of the pictures for the division and others that are related to the hobby of model railroading. The first priority will be given to members of Division 15. Note: when you get to the site, click on the pictures you want to view and they will pop up as a slide show. All individuals submitting photos for this site should send them to Mike Nicoletti. Credit will always be given to the photographer for their photos. If you have many photos, I would like to have them sent to me on a CD via the U.S. Postal Service. Your photos should be approximately 250x300 pixels. Our storage space is limited, so I must make sure we do not run out of space.

Finally, you will find at the bottom of the Home page and on the Meet the Board page e-mail addresses. You can click on the e-mail link or you can copy and paste it into your own address book. If you click on the e-mail address it may or may not directly link to your own personal e-mail browser. If this happens then copy and paste it into your personal e-mail.
